On Jan 10 th , CA Governor announced the proposal budget for education.	
This new budget will fully fund LCFF. (\$2.9 Billion)	
The governor offers one-time fund of \$1.8 Billion	
Additional funding is available for Career Tech Pathways (Grade 9 th -12 th) , Health insurance, Pre-school, early education and child care.	
CA is at bottom in US for school funding.	
Teacher workforce funding (\$100 Million) - Mostly for Credentialing programs

Increased costs for CalSTERS and CalPERS	
Special Education legal requirements	
Transportation and bussing	
Budget will be available for early use in January (conservative), will arrive in May 2018.	
New budget increase is about \$5.50 per ADA

Dashboard has color coded structure. Blue-green-orange-red		
Two consecutive year red performance will force schools to participate differentiated assistance program		
6 schools districts out of 32 is under program improvement. Berryessa USD is not one of them.
