School Resources—School Staffing Allocations

Allocations for the year will be adjusted in the fall to reflect actual enrollment on the fourth Friday of the school year and the discretionary allocation rate per pupil adopted by the Board of Trustees in conjunction with the adoption of the budget for the school year. In the event that a site has to form a class of new pupils after the fourth week, an adjustment will be made. Schools will be allocated basic staff as follows:

Discretionary Appropriations

Preliminary allocations for discretionary appropriations will be made between January and February of each year. The preliminary allocation will be based on projected enrollment for the following school year. The allocation for the year will be adjusted in October to reflect actual enrollment on the fourth Friday of the school year. The discretionary allocation rate per pupil shall be adopted by the Board of Trustees in conjunction with the adoption of the budget for the ensuing school year.

Final determination of the use of any positive ending balance will be made at the discretion of the Superintendent.

Any expenditure exceeding the budgeted discretionary appropriations will be carried forward as a charge against the appropriation for the following year.

The discretionary appropriation budget shall be prepared by the school principal. Allocations shall be used to support and implement school improvement plans. Discretionary appropriations may be budgeted within the following accounts:
