## **Attendance Accounting**

The Board of Trustees of Berryessa Union School District recognizes that Attendance Accounting is a vital function of District accounting. Much of the District's revenue is generated by Average Daily Attendance (ADA) and apportioned by the State Department of Education.

Unexcused absences will not be allowed as part of the Average Daily Attendance calculation per the regulations established by the State Department of Education. District administrators shall do everything possible to ensure that students attend school on a regular basis.

Enrollment in grades kindergarten through third shall be limited to the quotas established by the State Department of Education. Class size in these grades shall be closely monitored to avoid penalties which may be assessed for exceeding the maximum limit set.

Business Services shall be responsible for overseeing Attendance Accounting to ensure that state regulations are properly implemented.
