COMMUNITY RELATIONS

School Advisory Committees for Compensatory Education

Each school identified as a target area school for ECIA (Education Consolidation and Improvement Act), Chapter I funds or State Compensatory Education funds, will organize, maintain, and support a Compensatory Education School Advisory Committee. The School Advisory Committee may be a subcommittee of the School Council or the School Site Council. At least 50 percent of the membership of this Committee will be composed of parents of participating students. Each School Advisory Committee for Compensatory Education shall have the opportunity to elect at least one member to the District Advisory Committee. District policies and all state and federal regulations regarding Compensatory Education Advisory Committees will be followed.

Newly identified Chapter I or State Compensatory Education schools may organize planning committees from a list of parents of children eligible for services.

All parents must give their consent to participate as members of the School Advisory Committee or planning committee.
