INTERNAL BOARD POLICIES

Orienting New Board Members

The Board and the administrative staff shall assist new member(s)-elect to understand the Board's functions, policies and procedures, and the operation of the School District before legal membership takes place. The following methods shall be employed:

- 1. The electee shall be given selected materials on the function of the Board and the School District.
- 2. The incoming member shall be invited to meet with the Superintendent and other administrative personnel to discuss services they perform for the Board.
- 3. The incoming member shall be provided with a copy of the Board's policies and bylaws, administrative regulations, and copies of pertinent materials developed by the State School Board Association.
- 4. The electee may attend, at School District expense, workshops for newly elected trustees, as provided in the Education Code.
