INTERNAL BOARD POLICIES

Membership in Associations

The Board acknowledges that participation in recognized associations and organizations will provide the Board and staff with (a) access to newsletters, periodicals, and advisory services relating to public education, (b) representation in the decision-making process on actions affecting public education, and (c) in-service education from participation in meetings, conferences, clinics, and conventions.

<u>Group Memberships</u>--School Board membership in recognized associations such as the California School Boards Association, National School Boards Association, Association of California School Administrators, and the Association of Low Wealth School Districts will be maintained by the district.

<u>Individual Memberships</u>--Individual memberships in not more than two recognized educational associations may be provided for each member of the Board.

<u>Budget</u>--The Superintendent shall budget funds for group and individual memberships and for paying the costs at adequate participation in the activities of the recognized associations and organizations.
