## **Tutoring**

It is expected that appropriate effort will be made by staff members to resolve the learning problems of students before recommending that parents engage a tutor or seek other outside professional help. The Board believes that by maintaining a high quality instructional staff and providing for a rich and varied curriculum, the need for individual tutoring is minimized.

However, should individual tutoring be recommended in exceptional cases, the Superintendent is directed to establish appropriate conflict of interest rules.
