

STUDENTS**Intra-District Transfer Agreement Open Enrollment**

The Board of Trustees desires to provide options that meet the diverse needs, potential and interests of district students.

The Superintendent or designee is authorized to administer intra-district transfers. Parents may request an intra-district transfer to permit their children to attend a school other than the school designated to serve the attendance area where the pupil lives. Transfer requests will be reviewed on the basis of criteria contained in Administrative Guidelines for Policy 5116. It is the intent of Berryessa Union School District to assist parents with the selection of a school in the best interest of the district and family whenever possible. The Superintendent or designee shall determine the capacity of each district school. Transportation is a parent responsibility. Procedures for appeal shall be provided.
