Student Discipline and Code of Conduct

Creating School Expectations and Procedures for Pupil Discipline

Each school site shall develop expectations and procedures for pupil discipline. In developing these expectations and procedures, each school shall solicit the participation, views, and advice of the school site council.

The final version of the expectations and procedures on school discipline with attendant regulations shall be adopted by the school principal and the school site council annually by May 30 for the following school year. It shall be the duty of each employee of the school to enforce the adopted expectations and procedures on school discipline.

Corporal punishment shall not be used as a disciplinary measure against any pupil. School administrators and teachers shall employ other means of disciplining pupils who violate school expectations or District policies or regulations. The use of reasonable and necessary force by an employee to protect oneself or pupils or to prevent damage to District property shall not be considered corporal punishment.

At the beginning of each school year, written copies of the school expectations will be given to all parents, guardians, and pupils of the school and also provided to transfer pupils and their parents or guardians at the time of enrollment.
