STUDENTS

Pupils Remaining at School After Dismissal Time

Pupils may remain at school after dismissal time for disciplinary reasons, to complete instructional assignments, to participate in school-sponsored programs, or when an emergency situation may pose a threat to health or safety. Parents or guardians shall be notified prior to such action except when approved by the principal or designee due to an emergency or when it is deemed to be in the best interest of the pupil. In such cases, the parent/guardian shall be notified the same day of the reasons for the principal's decision.

All athletic and social activities of pupils, where ever held, if conducted under the name or auspices of the school or of any class, shall be under the direct supervision of certificated employees of the District.

When pupils are provided transportation by District school bus, it shall be the responsibility of the principal or designee to determine that a safe means of transportation is available to the pupil from school to home for pupils remaining after dismissal time.
