

BYLAWS OF THE BOARD

Adoption and Amendment of Administrative Regulations

To carry out the intentions expressed in Board policy, the Superintendent or designee shall develop Administrative Regulations and/or procedures specifying detailed actions to be taken and arrangements to be enforced within the district and its schools. Administrative Regulations shall be consistent with state and federal law and regulations, Board policy, and negotiated employee contracts.

The Board does not adopt Administrative Regulations unless specifically required to do so by law, or unless requested to do so by the Superintendent.

The Board may review and direct revisions of Administrative Regulations should they, in the Board’s judgment, be inconsistent with the policies adopted by the Board.

Administrative Regulations may be presented for Board review at the same time as a proposed Board Policy or proposed revision to a Board Policy.
