PARTICIPATION IN BOARD MEETINGS BY COMMUNITY MEMBERS

BOARD MEETING DEFINITION

The Board meetings are not public meetings; however, other than closed sessions, they are meetings of the Board of Trustees held in public.

BOARD MEETING-INFORMATION ITEM

The Board receives information from the administration. Members of the public may provide additional information. If members of the public raise questions, they may be referred to the administration for follow-up and future response.

BOARD MEETING-ACTION ITEM

The Board receives information from the administration and a recommendation from the Superintendent. Members of the public may provide additional information and opinions.

BOARD MEETING/STUDY SESSION

Board meetings/study sessions are for the Board.

BOARD TOWN HALL MEETING-DEFINITION

Board Town Hall Meetings are special community Board meetings. No actions are taken at these meetings. They are conducted by the Board for the sole purpose of listening to public comments, concerns, and complaints.

ADMINISTRATIVE TOWN HALL MEETING-DEFINITION

Administrative Town Hall meetings are not Board meetings, although Board members may attend. These meetings are conducted by the administration for the public.
