<b>Physical Fitness</b>	All students unless their IEP indicates exempt	<b>5 and 7</b>	<b>Grades 5 – 7</b> Aerobic Capacity, Abdominal Strength and Endurance, Upper Body Strength and Endurance, Body Composition, Trunk Extensor Strength and Flexibility, Flexibility	February - May
