4. Open Agenda Items

4.1 Review Behavior Matrix overview & next steps - Dr. McCreary

Continuation of general review of the Behavior Matrix and assisting with development of CCEIS Plan, focusing on intervention and supports to minimize suspensions. Utilizing MTSS (Multi-Tiered System of Support), Matrix will support Principals in uniformly addressing student behavior. Four Principals piloting MTSS next two months will present to the School Board by the end of the current school year.

4.2 Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) overview & next steps - Dr. McCreary

Review LCAP Survey results of all three LCAP goals and gather feedback:

Goal #1 Ensure a safe and productive learning environment - 88% of students surveyed. Action items include: Ongoing implementation of MTSS, PBIS, student wellness, including more support for SEL

Goal #2 Improving ELL Reclassification - Metrics shown with following feedback: 1) Need of alignment of Intervention Strategies; 2) Instructional Coaches supporting teachers in reading intervention strategies, new teacher induction, SEAL and FOSS Science; 3) Technology; 4) Electives in VAPA (Visual and Performing Arts) standards. In progress action items include: Culturally Responsive teaching/Implicit Bias training, ELA intervention by ICs, ELD (SEAL) and ELD Middle School professional development, After-school Elevate Math, Foss Science implementation, Mandarin Immersion program in middle school (SMT) 2023-24, and Illuminate Platform (adaptive learning).

Goal #3 Parent Involvement - Continue to develop better strategies and implement ways to engage with the community. Action items include: 1) Expand translated parent communications via contract with Communicaid; 2) Parent Engagement nights at school sites (i.e. Reclassification Certification ceremony); 3) Suggestion of Parent Ambassadors.

Next Steps for LCAP: Review LCAP data and feedback (5/25/23), present LCAP to School Board (6/4/23), and submit for approval (6/28/23).

Question regarding next Interim Budget report: Next interim report will likely be in June due to the State budget May Revise coming out mid-May.
