4.2 SBAC Data Overview - Dr. Joe McCreary

2021-22 was the first year of SBAC testing after a two-year pause due to Covid pandemic. Overall, there was a 1% increase in English Language Arts scores and 4% drop in Mathematics scores. Dr. McCreary shared data by schools and sub-groups. Discussion evolved around identifying target students at school sites, intervention, and funding from sources such as ELOP (Education Learning Opportunity) fund.

4.3 District Declining Enrollment - Kevin Franklin

Mr. Franklin shared current enrollment dropped more than projections of declining enrollment in all grades from the May 2022 BDAC meeting. Further data analysis suggests the cause may be due to families moving out of state, particularly in the Northwood/Morrill school area where enrollment in Kindergarten saw a significant drop. An estimated 2.65M loss in revenue could be expected. Enrollment/ADA revenue projections will be updated for the 1st interim report in December.

4.4 COVID Testing - Dr. Roxane Fuentes

CDPH covid testing ended in the 2021-22 school year. District continues on-site Covid testing with Campus Clinic and welcomes staff, students, and the community. Registration is required. Testing is at the District Office M-TH and Middle School sites two days per week. Campus Clinic offers Rapid and PCR testing.
