## **BUSINESS**

## **Insurance**

There shall be established in the District a safety and health education program to provide a high degree of safety for students, visitors, and employees of the District. Such a program shall comply with the requirements of the Education Code, Labor Code, and the California Occupational Safety and Health Act.

- A. The Superintendent shall establish committees, advisory to the Superintendent, to implement and monitor the District Safety and Health Program.
- B. The site administrator of each school and other department heads shall be responsible for maintaining safe and sanitary conditions in facilities under their jurisdiction in accordance with the California Occupational Safety and Health Act of 1973.
- C. Site administrators shall insure that teachers instruct students in their classes in the general rules of health and safety.
- D. All employees shall maintain safe and sanitary conditions in their teaching or work area of responsibility.
