Administrative Regulation

COMMUNITY RELATIONS

District Advisory Committee for Compensatory Education

A District Advisory Committee for the Compensatory Education program shall be established annually. The purpose of the Committee is to promote cooperation, understanding, and coordination of the Compensatory Education programs operated under Chapter I of the Education Consolidation and Improvement Act of 1981 and State Compensatory Education. The Committee shall provide advice and assistance by:

- 1. Planning, implementing, and evaluating the ECIA, Chapter I program, and/or State Compensatory Education program.
- 2. Disseminating information to parents.
- 3. Mobilizing community resources to supplement District Compensatory Education programs.
- 4. Acting as a hearing board of individuals or groups that wish to propose changes in the ECIA, Chapter I program.

The Committee shall be advisory only and shall have no power to enter into contracts, spend public funds, or veto ECIA, Chapter I programs.

Membership

The District Advisory Committee shall be composed of representatives from each school advisory committee for ECIA, Chapter I and/or State Compensatory Education program. Two parent representatives and one staff representative shall be selected by each School Advisory Committee. The members may serve for a term of two years.

The Director of School Services and Projects and the Principal of each school receiving ECIA, Chapter I funds may also be members of the Advisory Committee.

Officers

The officers of the District Advisory Committee for Compensatory Education shall be chairperson, vice-chairperson, and secretary. The chairperson shall be a parent. Officers shall be elected to serve for two years and can be re-elected. Any officer may be removed by two-thirds vote of the total membership of the Committee whenever, in the judgment of the Committee, the best interest of the Committee would be served thereby.

District Advisory Committee for Compensatory Education

Executive Committee

An executive committee, composed of the officers of the committee and the ECIA, Chapter I, director, shall meet preceding Advisory Committee meetings to review the progress made by the Advisory Committee and to plan the agenda for subsequent meetings.

Meetings

The Advisory Committee shall meet regularly. Special meetings may be called by the chairperson or the executive committee. All meetings shall be preceded by a written announcement mailed to all Advisory Committee members or a personal telephone call to the members.
