Adjusted School Week

Adjusted School Week Schedule

- A. Procedure for the Establishment of an Adjusted School Week:
 - 1. Establish number of minutes in standard school day as provided in Policy 6112--School Day.
 - 2. Establish number of minutes in the school week by multiplying school day by five.
 - 3. Establish a schedule providing for not less than minimum school day as provided in California Education Code Sections 46112 and 46113. The minimum day for grades 1, 2, and 3 is 230 minutes. The minimum day or grades 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 is 240 minutes. The kindergarten schedule shall not be adjusted.
 - 4. Subtract the number of minutes for the adjusted day schedule (step 3) from the total number of minutes of instruction per week (step 2) and divide remainder by 4.
 - 5. Establish a four (4) non-adjusted day schedule to provide the number of minutes of instruction indicated by step 4.
 - 6. Complete school schedule form.

Staff Development Plan for Adjusted School Week

- A. Procedure for the Establishment of a Staff Development Plan:
 - 1. Complete a Policy 6111 "School Staff Development Plan" form for the school year or all information contained on form.
 - 2. Attach an analysis and explanation of how the program plan will affect other school and district services; i.e., schedules for transportation, cafeteria, central office.
