INSTRUCTION

Classroom Instructional Grants

The Board of Trustees encourages teachers to develop and submit grant proposals designed to enhance the learning opportunities and experiences of pupils. Grant proposals should be based upon the established District instructional priorities, the School Improvement Plan, and/or the adopted grade-level expectations. Principals will review and approve grant applications unless prohibited by contract, funding source, or law.

Classroom grants are to supplement or enrich the basic instructional program. Grants may not be used to purchase materials that would replace the basic textbook. Any materials purchased must supplement the District's adopted programs.

All commercially produced materials and equipment become the property of the District. Any equipment will be labeled, inventoried, and assigned to the school at which the teacher works. If the teacher changes schools within the District, he/she may request that the equipment also be transferred. The decision to transfer equipment rests with the principal. If the teacher leaves the District, all materials and equipment will remain at the school and remain the property of Berryessa Union School District.
