INSTRUCTION

Minimum Proficiency Standards

The Board of Trustees shall adopt district standards of proficiency in reading comprehension, computational skills, and writing. Pupils shall be assessed for these basic skills and receive remedial instruction when needed.

Minimum proficiency standards will be assessed in English. Differential standards may be applied for Special Education pupils and non-English speaking pupils.

The Superintendent or designee shall provide for the periodic screening of assessment instruments for racial, cultural or sexual bias.
