

INSTRUCTION

Gifted and Talented Education Program

The Berryessa Union School District shall organize and provide learning programs to prepare gifted children to become creatively productive, self-directed adults who will be responsive to the needs of the society in which they live. The District will provide differentiated instructional materials in order to meet the needs of gifted and talented students. Methods of instruction should be selected that will provide an environment in which individual, small group, and large group instruction is utilized to meet individual abilities and needs.

The aims of the program are as follows:

1. Provide maximum opportunities for personal development in the area of knowledge, understanding, and thinking; and in the area of attitude and purpose.
2. Guide each child to an awareness, understanding and appreciation of full potential as an individual.

The Superintendent shall organize and implement programs for identified students attending District schools as provided under California Education Code, Article 14, Chapter 6, Division 6 (52200-52208); and California Administrative Code, Title V.
