Master Plan for School Improvement

Responsibilities of the School

Improvement of instruction at the school site is an important responsibility of each school staff, the governing Board, school site councils, and other District employees. All schools, both SIP-funded and non-funded schools, shall be committed to the improvement of the instructional program, support services, and school environment. The elements of the Berryessa Master Plan for School improvement (Policy 6500) shall apply to all schools.

Each school is to develop a three-year School Improvement Plan. The requirements for these school plans will be established in accordance with the District Base Plan, the California Education Code (including State guidelines), and related policies of the Board of Trustees.
