INSTRUCTION

Terminating Unsuccessful Programs

The District Evaluation Committee will review each School Improvement Program at the end of the second year of implementation. The Committee will make recommendations, as needed, to the school for improving the program for the third year of implementation. The Committee will make a final evaluation at the end of year three, and will make a recommendation to the governing Board to continue special funding for the program, or to terminate special funding. In non-funded schools the Committee will report recommendations to the Governing Board and the School Council.

Criteria for Evaluation

The District Evaluation Committee will use the following criteria in reviewing the implementation of School Improvement Programs:

- 1. Degree of attainment of stated objectives in student achievement, staff development, and parent participation.
- 2. Degree of program compliance with Board Policy, Administrative Guide-lines, State laws and State regulations.
- 3. Degree of efficiency in fiscal management.
