Release Time to Advise Students or Conduct Staff Development Programs

Under School Based Coordinated Program, all schools may apply for a maximum of eight (8) days of calendar interruptions as a portion of the approved School Plan.

The Board must establish criteria and procedures for approving or disapproving requests from schools, as part of theft School Based Coordination Program, for the provision of time during the regular school year to conduct staff development programs and receive full average daily attendance reimbursement, pursuant to Education Code Section 52022. Such time shall not exceed eight days each year for each participating staff member. (Education Code Section 52022; California Administrative Code, Title V, Section 4022(e); Board Policy 6111; Administrative Guidelines 6111.)
