

INTERNAL BOARD POLICIES

Methods of Operation

The Board has the power of establishing its own procedures, subject to the requirements of state law. Wherever the law, these Internal Board Policies, or the Bylaws of the Board are silent on a procedural matter, that matter shall be governed by the New Robert's Rules of Order, Revised Edition 1993 (Barnes & Noble). Whenever a conflict exists between these Internal Board Policies and Robert's Rules, or between the Bylaws of the Board and Robert's Rules, the provisions of these Internal Board Policies or of the Bylaws of the Board shall control.

The Board shall concern itself primarily with broad questions of policy, rather than with administrative details. The implementation of policies is an administrative task to be performed by the Superintendent and staff, who shall be held responsible for the effective administration and supervision of the school district's programs and operations.
