NEW CONSTRUCTION

General Policy Statement

Providing for proper plant facilities is a major responsibility of the Board and the District administration. The selection of sites and the design of a plant that provides adequacy of space and flexibility of use all combine to impinge upon or enhance the instructional program.

Since construction is costly and buildings, when constructed, become a permanent part of the community to be used by a large number of people, great care must be taken to be sure that the facilities will be appropriately designed for best use both now and in the future.

The Board recognizes that new district construction is just one facet of the total community development. It is the intent of the Board to fully evaluate the impact of new construction on the neighborhood and the total community. The safety implications of increased vehicular traffic, as well as pedestrian traffic, shall be of prime concern. The impact upon all actual or potential human problems will be evaluated prior to selection of site or decisions regarding design or actual construction.
