Admitting Pupils to Kindergarten and to First Grade

Berryessa Union School District admits pupils, who have established legal residence, to kindergarten as prescribed by the State of California Education Code, Administration Code and District Administrative Guidelines 5100.

Pupils are admitted to first grade upon successful completion of kindergarten in Berryessa Union School District or another public school In California. Pupils completing kindergarten in a nonpublic school or in another state shall be admitted to first grade as prescribed by legal state statutes. District procedures shall be consistent in all schools.
