Administrative Regulation

STUDENTS

Monitoring of Non-Public/Non-Sectarian Schools

- 1. School principals in the Berryessa Union School District are to report to the Director of Pupil Services, any pupil not attending school regularly who may be attending a non-public/non-sectarian school in another district or within the Berryessa Union School District.
- 2. The Director of Pupil Services (Attendance Supervisor) will determine whether a current affidavit has been filed for a non-public/non-sectarian school with the County Schools Office, which has been approved by the State Superintendent. (The County Schools Office mails copies of all affidavits to each district.)
- 3. Upon receipt of an affidavit that a non-public/non-sectarian school is located within the school district, the Director of Pupil Services will communicate, in writing, with the administration of the non-public/non-sectarian school and state that Berryessa Union School District has an affidavit on file and offer any assistance that is appropriate.
