Sneak a Peek Game

This activity will teach participants how to problem solve in a group and communicate effectively.

1. The instructor will build a small sculpture with some of the building blocks and hide it from the group.

2. One member from each team can come up at the same time to look at the sculpture for ten seconds and try to memorize it before returning to their team.

3. After they return to their teams, they have twenty-five seconds to instruct their teams about how to build an exact replica of the instructor's sculpture. After one minute of trying to recreate the sculpture, another member from each team can come up for a "sneak a peek" before returning to their team and trying to recreate the sculpture.
