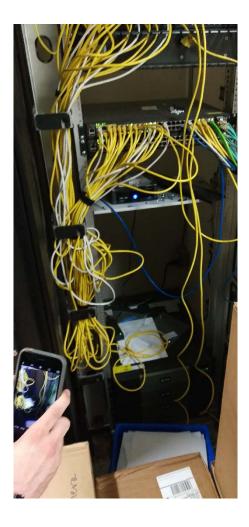
MEASURE L BOND CONSTRUCTION UPDATE August 9, 2016

- 1. Phase II Technology Upgrade Cabling
 - Stage I Cabling Upgrades:
 - Unforeseen work causing delays
 - Piedmont, Toyon, Summerdale near completion
 - Majestic Way in progress
 - Laneview potentially delayed, may complete individual wings during Feb. & Apr. 2017 breaks
 - Stage II Cabling Upgrades
 - MOT awarded Thanksgiving Break
 - Stage III Cabling Upgrades:
 - Noble awarded Winter Break
