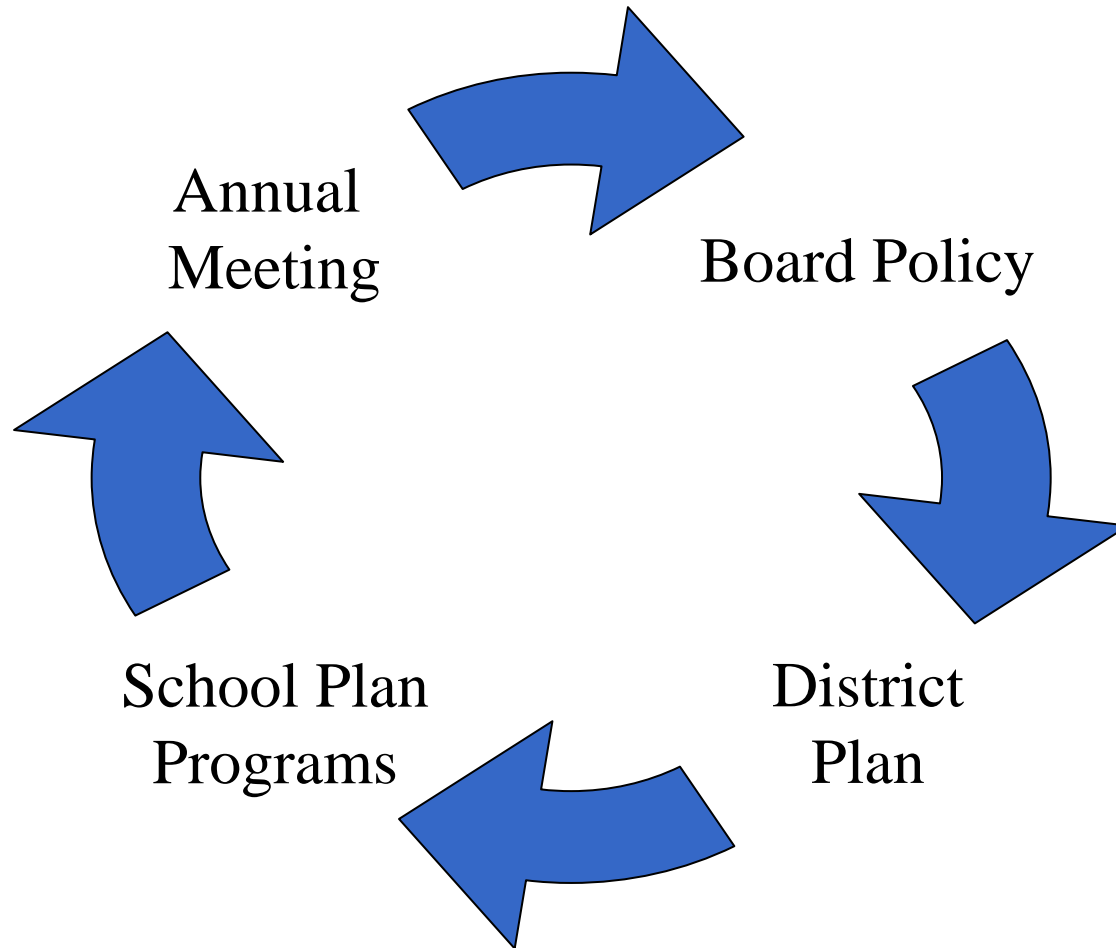

Parent Survey

- A total of 1760 parents completed the Parent Survey across the District in 2010-11.
- This year we currently have over 2,500 with a closing date of April 26

Survey Categories

- The questions cover four major areas:
 - ◆ School culture and environment
 - ◆ Safety
 - ◆ Communication
 - ◆ Educational Programs
- Parents of second language learners are asked additional questions on the English Language Advisory Committees at their sites.

Survey Reporting

- Each school will receive district results and their school site results for comparison.
- Data will be shared with parents and used as one source of information to build action plans for the Single School Plan and for the annual review of the district plan.

Next Steps

- The district will review multi-year plan to improve parent engagement and support parent advocacy within the school system. These results will help guide that work.
